

CLAYESMORE SCHOOL FEES AND CHARGES – ACADEMIC YEAR 2011 / 2012

It is, of course intended to maintain the above fees for the academic year. Parents will appreciate, however, that the Council of the School reserves the right to adjust the fees during the year if circumstances make this necessary.

Monthly Payments - The School is able to provide information on a monthly payment scheme provided through a third party on application to the Bursary.

INSURANCES

PERSONAL ACCIDENT (including DENTAL) INSURANCE

All pupils will automatically be covered under an insurance scheme, which provides a sum of up to £600,000 in the event of an accident that results in permanent disability and up to £10,000 for emergency dental treatment. Cost: Nil - no additional charge to school fees: we provide this cover automatically, free of charge.

PUPILS ABSENCE INSURANCE

This provides for the refund of school fees paid in the event of your child being absent from school through illness or accident for a period of 4 days or more. Inevitably, from time to time a pupil may be unwell and unable to attend school for a period of time. In such circumstances we cannot refund fees for the period missed; this is where this Scheme steps in and each year we have parents who are glad they took this up. The premium for this cover will be added to your termly fee bill unless you advise us you do not wish to participate in the scheme. Cost: 0.8% of the basic termly fee. (i.e. the net fee after any Bursary or Scholarship discount)

PERSONAL EFFECTS SCHEME

Personal Effects insurance to cover for loss or damage to your childrens' possessions (excluding mobile phones) up to a total sum insured of £4,000. The premium will be added to your termly fee bill unless you advise us you do not wish to participate in the scheme.

Cost: £10 per term

BUPA SCHOOLS SCHEME

BUPA private medical insurance for your child is simple to join and does not exclude pre-existing conditions. Details and an application form are available from the Bursary. If you wish your child to be covered please complete and return the application form to us prior to the start of any term and the premium will be added to your fee bill. Cost: £63 per term

LEARNING SUPPORT CENTRES

PREPARATORY SCHOOL

Charges are now assessed depending on individual need and notified to parents termly.

SENIOR SCHOOL

(Including EAL)

1 pupil: £27.46 per lesson
2 pupils: £14.96 each per lesson
3 pupils: £11.53 each per lesson
4 pupils: £8.60 each per lesson
5 pupils or more: £7.00 each per lesson

When needed charges for reading and scribing for external Examinations attract an additional charge at £45.50 per hour.

CASUAL BOARDING

SENIOR SCHOOL

£22.00 per night – unless the pupil is required to stay for a school function – reduced to £11.00

PREPARATORY SCHOOL

£20.00 per night (part-time boarding minimum two nights a week every week of a term).

SENIOR SCHOOL

Individual lessons: £25.95 per lesson
Paired lesson: £12.95 each per lesson

PREPARATORY SCHOOL

Individual lessons: £22.35 per lesson
Paired lessons (Years 5 to 8): £11.20 each per lesson
Group lessons (Years 3 and 4): £5.70 each per lesson

EXTERNAL OR ADDITIONAL SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES

Both the Senior School and the Prep School arrange a wide variety of activities such as the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme, riding, certain specialist individual coaching, life saving and sailing. Parents are always consulted before such activities are booked and costs advised at that time.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES TO PUPILS

The School Medical Centre can arrange private medical or dental appointments but only with the prior written permission of parents.

Transport - Charges are automatically made for transport of pupils to medical and other appointments. Exceptionally the School will arrange and pay for taxi or rail tickets for pupils on written request from parents.

School Minibus fees are billed termly in advance for routine trips. A full term's notice is required to cancel a regular booking: such notice must be acknowledged by the School before charges will cease. Additional trips for both day and boarding pupils are billed at the end of each term.

PREP SCHOOL CHARGES

All extra charges including shop purchases are notified to parents.

Prep School Parents' Association – Current parents' group formed to support the working of the Prep School in providing the 'cream on the cake' every now and then via social events and fundraising events like the Christmas Fair – a subscription of £10 per family is automatically charged each term.

Prep School boarders who remain in at a weekends automatically incur a variable small charge for a group outing on a Sunday and for 'Tuck' once a week. Further detail is available from the house parents.

SENIOR SCHOOL CHARGES

There are a number of trips, events and extra purchases that individually cost less than £20. Our policy is that we allow up to £20 to be placed on the school bill as these items occur. Items over £20 and purchases made in the School Shop are normally notified to parents before the event if at all possible. The £20 limit is reviewed annually.

Friends of Clayesmore – This is a current parents' group, which supports the Senior School with fundraising events and the like and provides financial support to certain School projects and activities – the £7 per term per child subscription is automatically charged. Further detail is provided in the joining pack.

Clayesmore Society – This is aimed at parents and former pupils, staff, governors and anyone wishing to remain associated with the School. It includes membership of the Old Clayesmorian Society for life for pupils. The life subscription (for child and his/her parents) is £300, automatically charged at £50 per term for the first 6 terms of a child's time in the Senior School.

House Subscriptions/Events – houses charge some form of subscription to allow the house to have a small fund to support pupils in a variety of ways. Parents are normally notified about this by house staff and other additional costs for outings, takeaways etc. that occur from time to time. Parents should liaise direct with Housemasters/Housemistresses for further detail.

Senior Boarding Pupils' "Spends" – All boarding pupils are provided with £3 per week 'spends' or 'pocket' money, which is charged to parents as an extra in arrears unless cancelled.

Naming of clothing in the Senior School – it is Senior School policy that all pupils on joining will be charged (up to £20) for specialist heat press name tapes which the School fixes to sports clothing and their replacements during the child's time with the senior school.

During formal external exam study years (10-13) pupils are expected to use and annotate subject books and to have permanent personal access to specialist reference material. Where books are provided for personal annotation, or when the School provides magazines, these are charged to pupils' accounts.

For those pupils participating in the CCF there is a standing subscription of £9 per term. Significant amounts of expensive equipment are issued to pupils and this is charged if lost or not returned to the CCF Stores. Appropriate insurance cover is advisable.
